# **Mission and Vision Statements**

# **Our Mission**

Focused Interruption, Inc. is committed to empowering communities, reducing violence, and fostering resilience through proactive outreach, trauma-informed care, and mentorship programs. We strive to provide pathways for healing and hope, creating opportunities for individuals and families to thrive.

# **Our Vision**

We envision a community where every individual has access to safety, support, and the resources needed to achieve their fullest potential. Through collaboration and innovative solutions, we aim to build a society free from violence, rooted in equity, and centered on healing.

# **Description of Activities**

Focused Interruption, Inc. (FI) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to building safer and more resilient communities by addressing the root causes of violence and providing holistic support to those impacted. Our mission is carried out through the following key initiatives:

## **Outreach: Preventing Violence and Promoting Stability**

Focused Interruption's Outreach Team works to prevent gun violence by developing relationships with people at highest risk of gun violence and engage these individuals in supportive services such as job placement or training, mental health treatment, legal services, and childcare. Throughout this process our highly trained Outreach Team, many of whom who have lived experience with violence and incarceration, provide ongoing mentoring, life coaching and dispute mediation to people at highest risk of community gun violence.

### Community Safety Work (CSW): Developing Community Engagement and Collaboration

The purpose of Focused Interruption's Community Safety Workers (CSWs) is to prevent violence in affected neighborhoods by acting as conflict mediators, social service connectors, and community builders. They collaborate with our outreach and support group programs to refer high-risk people to suitable services. Drawing from their own experiences and professional skills, CSWs help facilitate public safety through strong relationships with neighbors, police, and social services.

### Leaders of Tomorrow (L.O.T.): Empowering Future Leaders

Through our Leaders of Tomorrow (L.O.T.) program, Focused Interruption supports school aged youth who have strayed from a constructive path in their school and community lives. The program is designed to help young individuals make better choices, avoid incarceration, improve their lives, and develop solid career and educational goals. Through a combination of mentorship, skills training, and emotional support, the program aims to increase school engagement, foster a constructive role in community life, and reduce recidivism.

#### Brothers Against Odds (B.A.O.): Inspiring Growth and Achievement

The Brothers Against Odds (B.A.O.) initiative is a mentoring and goal setting program for young men at high/medium risk of gun violence victimization and perpetration. B.A.O. focuses on community readiness by working with community partners, parents, and schools to develop a post high school graduation plan that helps youth confidently transition into adulthood. The group meets weekly on Wednesdays to discuss issues like loyalty, friendship, dating, finances and other life skills and on Fridays to share progress and to meet on fun activities.

#### **Aftercare Services: Providing Trauma-Informed Support**

FI's Aftercare Services offer compassionate, trauma-informed care to individuals and families affected by violence. By addressing emotional, psychological, and practical needs, this initiative helps survivors heal and rebuild their lives with dignity and hope.

Focused Interruption, Inc. remains unwavering in its mission to empower communities, reduce violence, and create pathways to brighter, more equitable futures.

## **Comprehensive Report on Key Programs and Services**

Focused Interruption, Inc. remains steadfast in its commitment to reducing violence, fostering resilience, and empowering individuals and communities through proactive engagement and holistic support. Below is an overview of our core programs and their 2024 achievements:

## **Outreach Services: Proactive Engagement and Mentorship**

- **50+ clients served**: Comprehensive assistance included housing support, mental health care, and employment resources.

# Leaders of Tomorrow (L.O.T.): Empowering Future Change-Makers

Launched in 2024, the L.O.T. program equips young adults with the skills, knowledge, and opportunities to become impactful leaders in their communities. This year's milestones include:

- **Monthly workshops**: Focused on leadership, advocacy, and career development, fostering critical skills among participants.
- **Partnership development**: Collaborated with local organizations to offer internships and mentorship opportunities, enhancing participants' career readiness and professional networks.

# Brothers Against Odds (B.A.O.): Addressing Unique Challenges for Young Men

The B.A.O. program is designed to support young men in overcoming obstacles and achieving personal and professional success. This year, we:

- **Mentored 15+ participants**: Focusing on leadership development, academic achievement, and career preparation.
- **Daily neighborhood engagement**: Conducted activities to build trust, resilience, and a sense of community among participants.

# **Aftercare Services: Providing Trauma-Informed Recovery Support**

Our trauma-informed recovery services offer comprehensive care for survivors of violence and their families, addressing both immediate and long-term needs. Key outcomes for 2024 include:
